EVENT INSTRUCTION

The WDFPF proudly presents the World & European Full Power Championships 2026. This event will take place will over **21-22 Nov 2026**:

21 Nov 2026: All female athletes & all male athletes up to 82.5kg weight class: Equipped and Unequipped for World and European Full Power.

22 Nov 2026: All male athletes from 90kg and above weight class: Equipped and Unequipped for World and European Full Power.

Closing date for this event is 25 Oct 2026, after this time the electronic entry form will be disabled and entries will no longer be received.

Entry Fee Costs: 85 euros

Lifter may enter the Unequipped or the Equipped category but not both

Weigh-in.

All lifters must be present at weigh-in as per the time below on whatever day they are lifting. Late arrival will preclude participation.

0730 – 0900 Registration & Weigh in

1030 – Event starts

NB. All competitors must be present for weigh in during this time, those who arrival after

0900 will not be allowed to lift having missed the weigh in time. As a competitor you are responsible for ensuring any accommodation and travel time allow you the ability to make these timings.

There are no changes to weight class on the day. Lifters who have qualified by means of a qualification lift will be in the category they set the lift in and as detailed on the submitted entry form. Those who are unable to make their prescribed weight class will be permitted to lift as a guest only and be unable to set records or receive awards. The only exception to this rule is with respect to teen lifters where at the discretion of the BDFPA they may be allowed to make reasonable change to their weight class.

Participation/Qualification to lift.

To lift in the Full Power Event lifters must:

- Have a current active 2026 membership.
- Have qualified in a 2026 National event.
- To enter the World Full Power please refer to the minimal opening lift requirement as this rule will apply.
- To enter the European Full Power then no minimal opening lift will be required.

Opening lifts.

As per international event requirements each lifter MUST open on either the minimum lift for each discipline or higher. Details are linked here:

Warm Up & Competition set up

A competition platform will take centre piece with 3 warm up areas all equipped with competition plates, 2 combo racks and competition plates. With spectator seating available. Food will not be available onsite, but the map shows lots of places close by to purchase food offsite.

Presentations.

Awards will be received for the top 3 positions of age and weight class. Those who finish 4th and below will receive a mention and applaud. This does not apply to the SENIOR Class (24-39) who lift in the open category against all age classes and are placed in relation to their position in the flight not age class and will as such receive awards relative to the flight position. All presentations will take place at the competition of lifting each day, there is no provision for those who choose to leave before the event has finished.

Drugs Testing

Drug testing will be conducted. As per WDFPF requirements all participants are subject to drugs testing. Participants must not leave the venue without the permission of the Drugs Control Officer. Any lifter called for testing who has subsequently been found to have left the venue maybe subject to sanctions as per the WDFPF Drugs policy.

Claiming Records

If you believe you are setting an international record you are to verbally inform the desk prior to taking the lift, note records are not validated until drug test results are returned from all lifters.

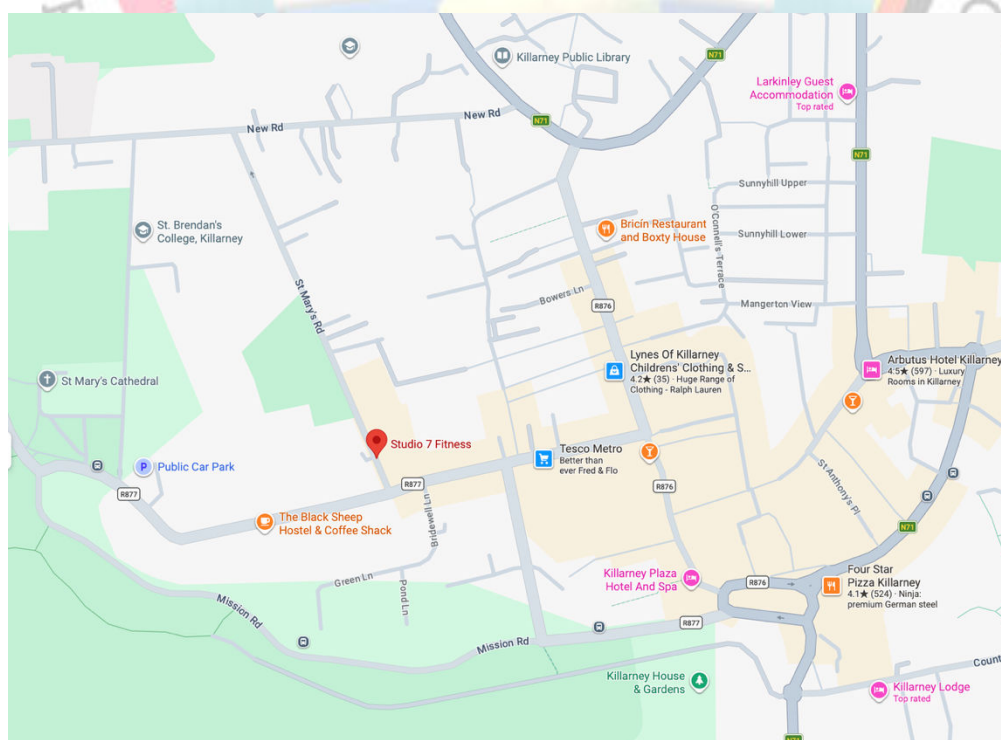
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Venue Facilities

Studio 7 is conveniently located in the heart of Killarney town centre, with cafés, restaurants, shops, and accommodation all within easy walking distance. Travel Information

Dublin Airport is about **314 km (195 miles) by road** from Killarney, and the drive typically takes around **3 hours 20 minutes** via the M7 and N21 roads.

Other travel options include:

- **Direct bus:** about **4 hours** from Dublin Airport to Killarney.
- **Train:** around **4 hours 40 minutes**, usually requiring a transfer at Mallow.
- **Flight to Kerry Airport:** about **55 minutes in the air**, plus airport transfer time.

By Train

Regular rail services operate from **Dublin Heuston Station to Killarney**, [check here](#) with journey times of approximately 4 hours.

By Bus
